- What day & approximate time you would arrive at the Missouri.

I am hoping to have most of the main details sorted out by our last meeting (the casting clinic) on June 23<sup>rd</sup>. Once the date has been confirmed, I will be asking for a deposit cheque made out for \$100 to the Calgary Hook & Hackle Club post dated to August 15th to hold your spot.
